

Established in 2005, the Partnership seeks to enhance education and community outcomes in Newman, Port Hedland, Onslow and remote schools within the Shire of East Pilbara and Town of Port Hedland.

The new iteration of the Partnership, 2021 to 2023, is a community-based approach to ensuring all students start school well-prepared and students are provided with clear pathways from primary to secondary school and into training, further study and employment.
