RCCI WA - New Work Health and Safety Laws FREE 60 minute Briefing Webinar - 13th June - 10am

The Work Health and Safety Act 2020 and Regulations has replaced WA's current Occupational Safety and Health Act as of March 31st 2022. This WHS Act is the framework to protect the health, safety and welfare of all workers at work and of other people who might be affected by work. The new laws brings vast changes in the continuing obligations of organisations, executives and workers, and associated penalties.

During this session, topics covered include

- Duty obligations of the Person Conducting the Business or Undertaking (PCBU)
- Duty obligations of Workers
- Due diligence obligations of Officers
- Penalties for Workplace fatalities – Industrial Manslaughter and Category 1 offences
- Snapshot of the new WHS Regulations
